• <u>Neutrality</u> – policy of not taking sides in a conflict between other countries (treats both sides equally).

#### Washington's Farewell Address

- Maintain commercial relations but stay politically detached.
- "The great rule of conduct for us, in regard to foreign nations, is, in extending our commercial relations, to have with them as little political connection as possible."



# How should the U.S. Respond?





The US Must Remain Neutral in fact as well as in Name

### • <u>Blockade –</u>

• the isolation by a warring nation of an enemy area (such as a harbor) by troops or warships to prevent passage of persons or supplies

#### • <u>Mine –</u>

 a type of bomb placed on or just below the surface of the ground or in the water that detonates when disturbed by a person, vehicle, or ship.





# Reasons for U.S. entry into World War I

- Financial Interests
  - American businessmen loaned 1 1/2 billion dollars to the Allies
- <u>Unrestricted Submarine Warfare</u>
  - Lusitania British passenger ship 1,198 killed 139 American
