

### Writing Systems

**Pictograms** (picture writing)

<u>Scribes</u> (trained writers) kept needed records.

Documents for tax collections, laws, and the storage of grain.




## Cities

• Cities emerged as farmers produced **surplus** (extra) food.

Agriculture (farming)
population

## Central Government

- ensured the food supply and protection.
- Bureaucracy is a system of managing gov't through departments run by officials



# Religion


Ancient people were **polytheistic**, believing in many gods.

Cities had temples and priests to gain the favor of gods through rituals to ensure plentiful crops.

**Job Specialization** 

People specialized in certain jobs.

Artisan- skilled craftworker













#### **Art and Architecture**

- Expressions of beliefs and values
- Buildings showed religion and strength in government.

#### **Social Classes**

- People became ranked in classes according to their job.
- Hierarchy a system of ranks
