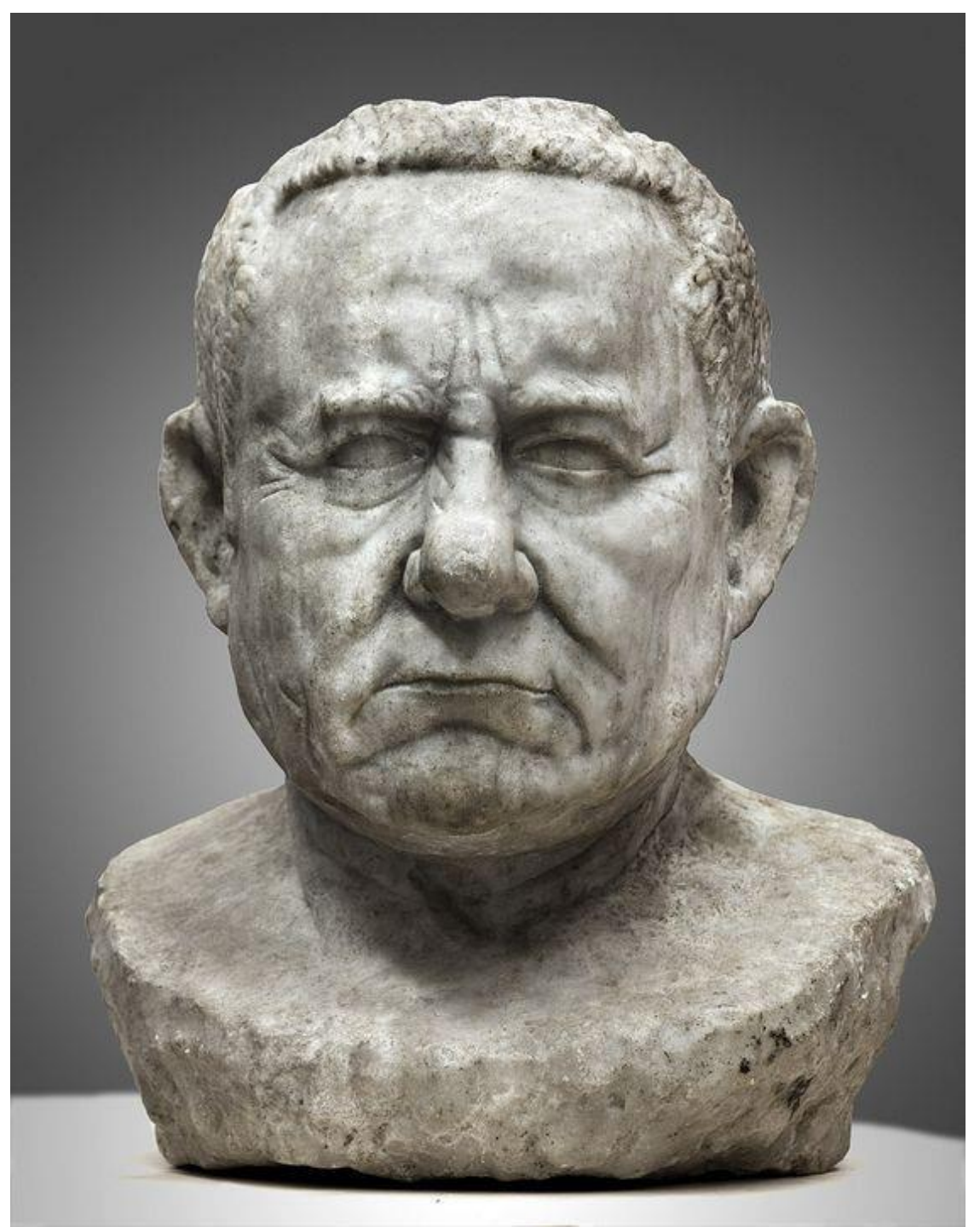

Sculpture

- Mass produced to show subjects throughout the empire what their rulers looked like
- Importance placed on realism
- Borrowed heavily from the Greeks



Architecture

- Great planners and engineers
- Practical buildings rather than aesthetic (beauty & emotion)
 - Arch-curved opening
 - Vault- arched roof
