Mesopotamia

- "The land between the rivers"
 - Rivers were NOT a reliable source of water
 - Ran dry in summer
 - flooded in spring

 create irrigation systems - built dams, canals, and ditches

Government

- <u>Theocracies</u> kings served as both government leaders AND high priests
- City-states
 - governed themselves
 - An independent political unit with its own government
 - protected by defensive walls
 - Engaged in near-constant wars


Sumer

- The first civilization to develop in Mesopotamia (5,500 B.C.E.)
- Sumerians shared common culture, language, and religion


Cities

- **<u>Ziggurat</u>** was the center of city life
 - Priests conducted rituals & sacrifices to city gods
 - Served as storage for grains, fabrics, gems

- Scribes were trained to read & write documents and stories
 - Epic of Gilgamesh oldest story in the world

Religion

- **polytheism** belief in more than one god
 - Each city-state had its own god
 - Negative outlook on life and the afterlife
 - Believed gods were selfish and had no regard for humans
