<u>Alliance:</u> an agreement between countries to help each other. Formed to advance common interests or causes $\checkmark Trading$

Pros (argument for)

- Can discourage an enemy attack
- Can help protect you from an enemy attack

Cons (argument against)

- Could get new enemies
- Allies can draw you into a war
- A nation might act more aggressive

Underlying Causes of World War I



• <u>M</u>ilitarism

- glorification of war - arms race - build up of weapons +

- <u>A</u>lliances
- <u>N</u>ationalism

- -more willing to risk war
- wanted to prove superiority –ethnic groups demanding independent nations

• Imperialism

- disputes over colonies
- <u>Assassination</u> <u>Immediate Cause "SPARK"</u> –assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand of Austria-Hungary by Gavrilo Princip a Serbian Nationalist

• <u>Militarism</u> Aggressive military preparation; exalting the military ideal: building a military culture

- <u>Imperialism</u> One nation taking over a weaker nation to exercise control over it
- <u>Nationalism</u> Devotion to the interests of one's nation or having pride in one's country



Who started World War I?

SERBIA:

- failed to stop Serbian nationalistS
- wanted to break-up Austrian Empire

AUSTRIA-HUNGARY:

used assassination as an excuse to crush Serbia

GERMANY:

- failed to stop Austrian aggression
 Declare 5 War Pr Russian

RUSSIA:

mobilized troops against Germany & Austria-Hungary

FRANCE:

actively supported Russia

BRITAIN:

- conditions of French support uncertain
- Encouraged German aggression
- Joined a war that was none of their business


