



# Impact of The Great Depression

- Unemployment hit 25%
- Business Failures
- Thousands of Bank Failures
- Stock Market Collapse
- Deflation overall drop in prices
- Poverty and Hunger
  - Hoovervilles communities of unheated shacks built of cardboard, tin or crates
    - Hoover Blankets newspapers for people who slept on benches
- Farm Failures/Foreclosures
  - <u>Dust Bowl</u> droughts in Texas, Oklahoma, Kansas, Colorado,
    & New Mexico


