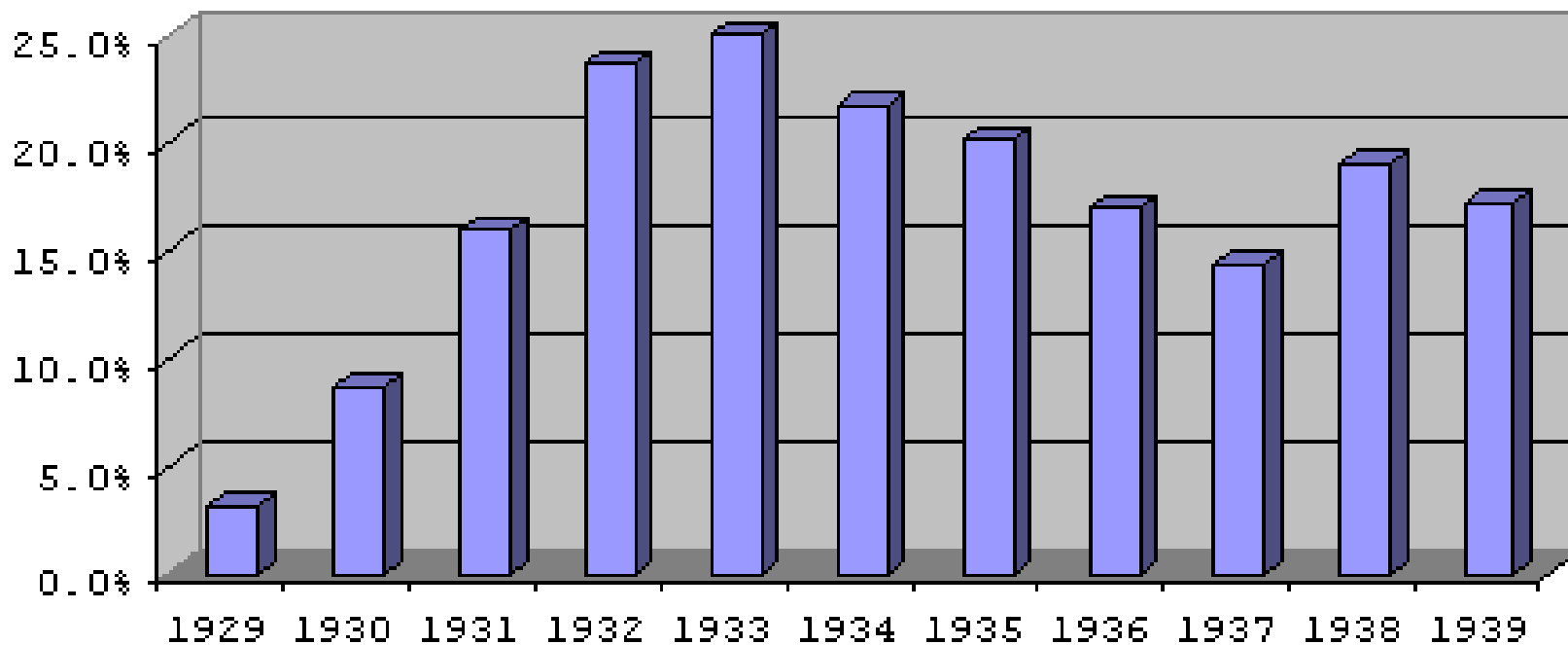

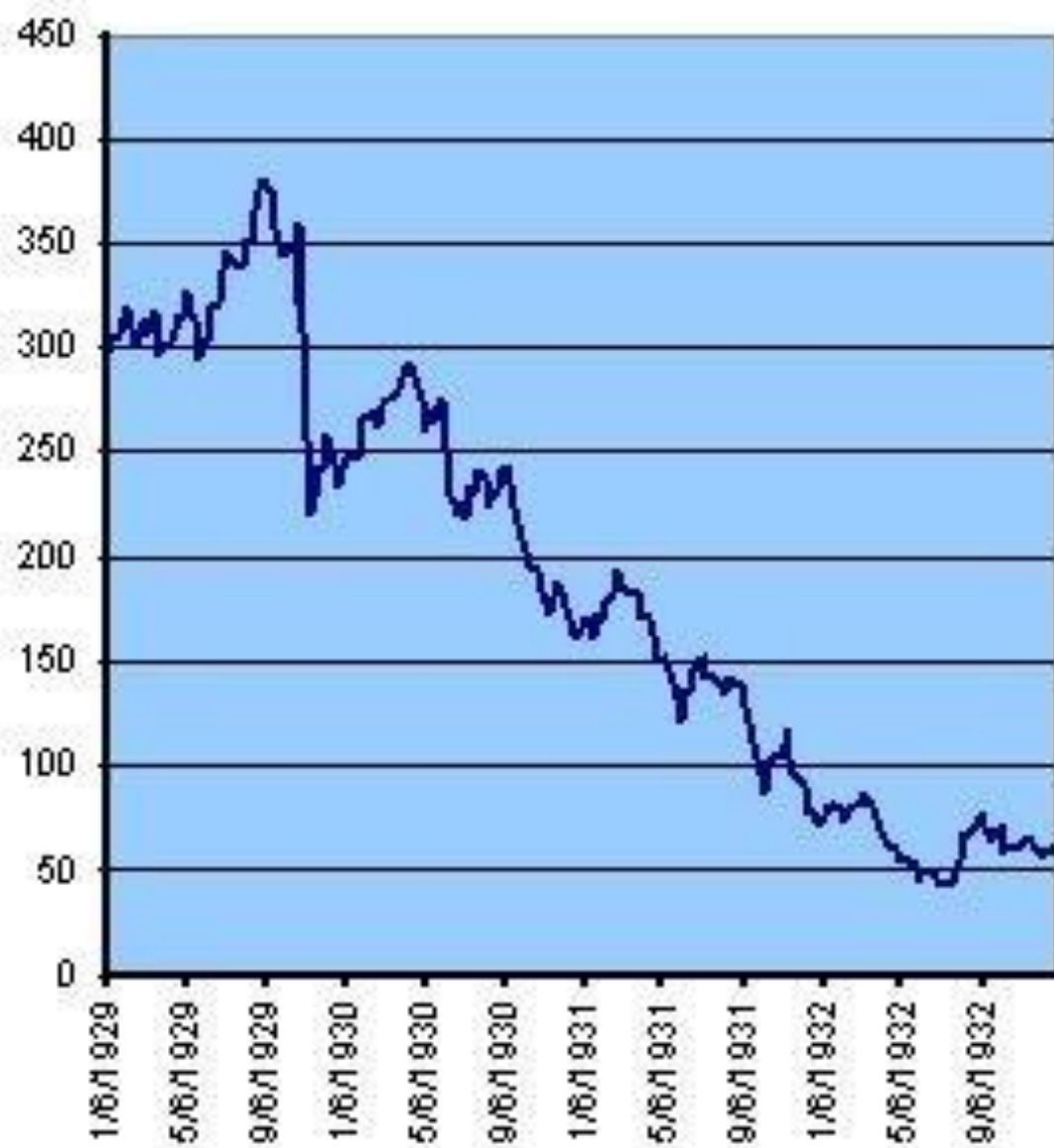

Impact of The Great Depression

- **Unemployment hit 25%**
- **Business Failures**
- **Thousands of Bank Failures**
- **Stock Market Collapse**
- **Deflation** – overall drop in prices
- **Poverty and Hunger**
 - **Hoovervilles** – communities of unheated shacks built of cardboard, tin or crates
 - **Hoover Blankets** – newspapers for people who slept on benches
- **Farm Failures/Foreclosures**
 - **Dust Bowl** – droughts in Texas, Oklahoma, Kansas, Colorado, & New Mexico

Rugged Individualism

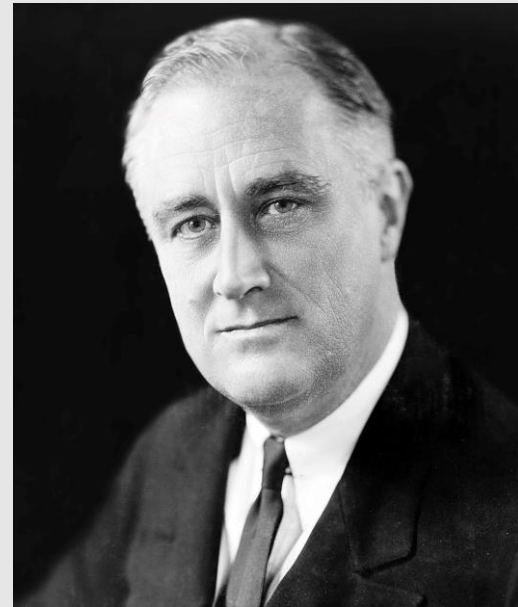
- People and society are better off when people have to do things with out help
