#### **Pearl Harbor**

- U.S. Naval Base Hawaii
- Surprise attack by Japan
- 2,403 Americans died and
- 1,178 were wounded.
- Eighteen ships were sunk or run aground, including five battleships.

#### Reasons Japan attacked Pearl Harbor

- Japan needed natural resources U.S. oil embargo
- Feared U.S. interference in Japanese expansion
- Weaken U.S. navy in the Pacific



### Reasons for U.S – Japanese conflict

- Stand up to Japanese aggression
- Prevent Japanese expansion in Asia
- Protect American interests (colonies) in Asia
