## Triangle Shirtwaist Fire

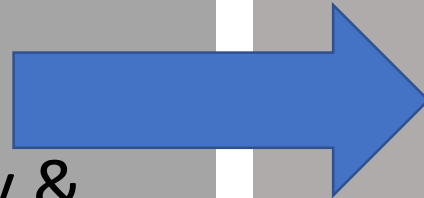
# PROBLEMS THAT THE TRIANGLE SHIRTWAIST FIRE EXPOSED
