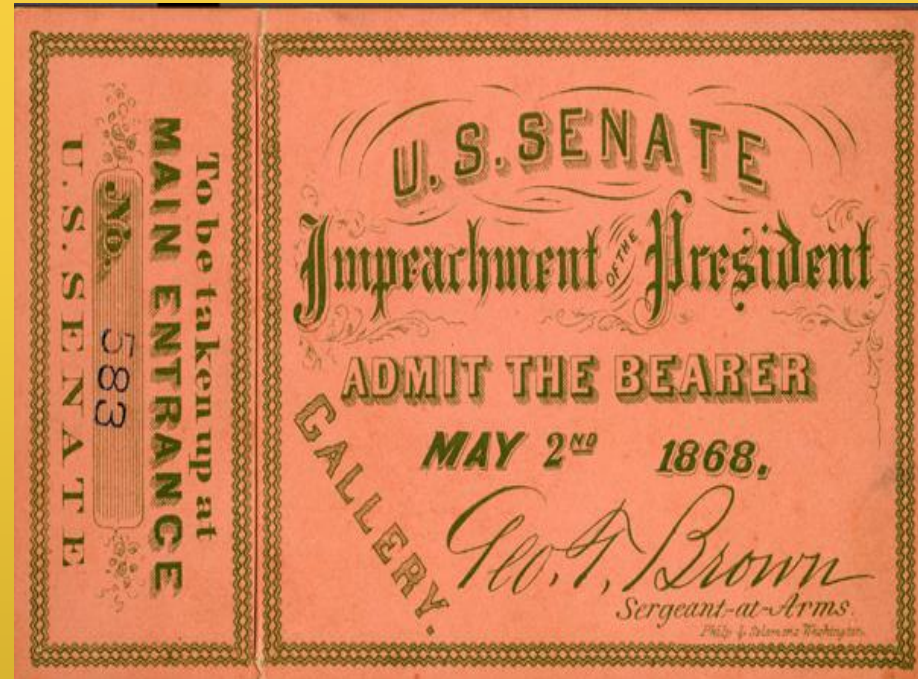

# How did the Radical Republicans Gain Control?

- Northern dissatisfaction with results of Presidential Reconstruction
- Congressional Elections of 1866 – radicals gained large majority
- Impeachment of Johnson
  - Violation of Tenure of Office Act
  - Senate did not vote to remove



# Radical Reconstruction (1867-77)

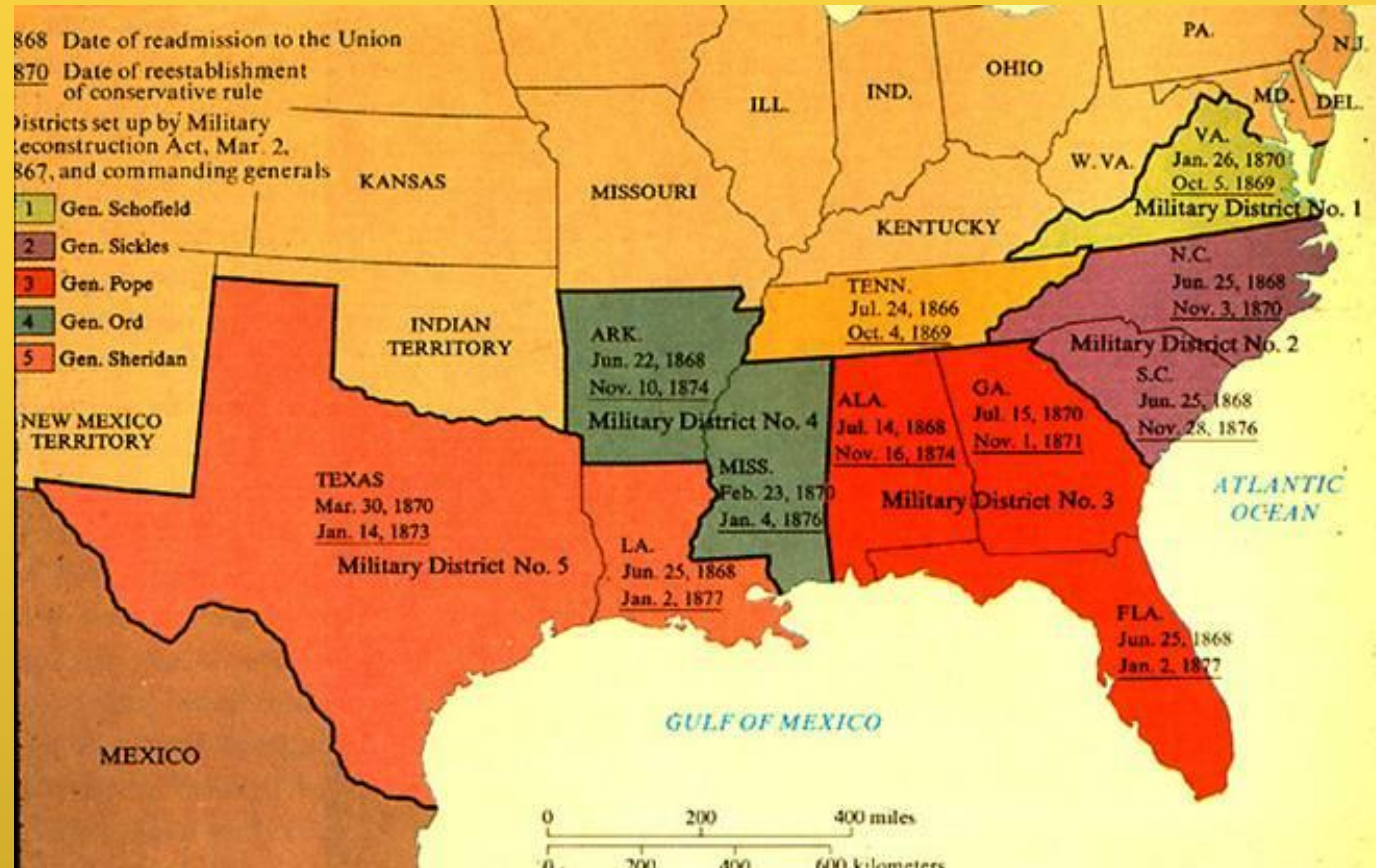
- **New Requirements for readmission**
  - Ratify 14<sup>th</sup> (1868)
  - Military Occupation of southern states (“Bayonet Rule”)
- **Greatly Expanded rights of African-Americans**
  - Extended Life of the Freedmen’s Bureau
  - 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> amendments (1870)

- Impeach

- House of Representatives brings charges.
- Senate – votes to remove
