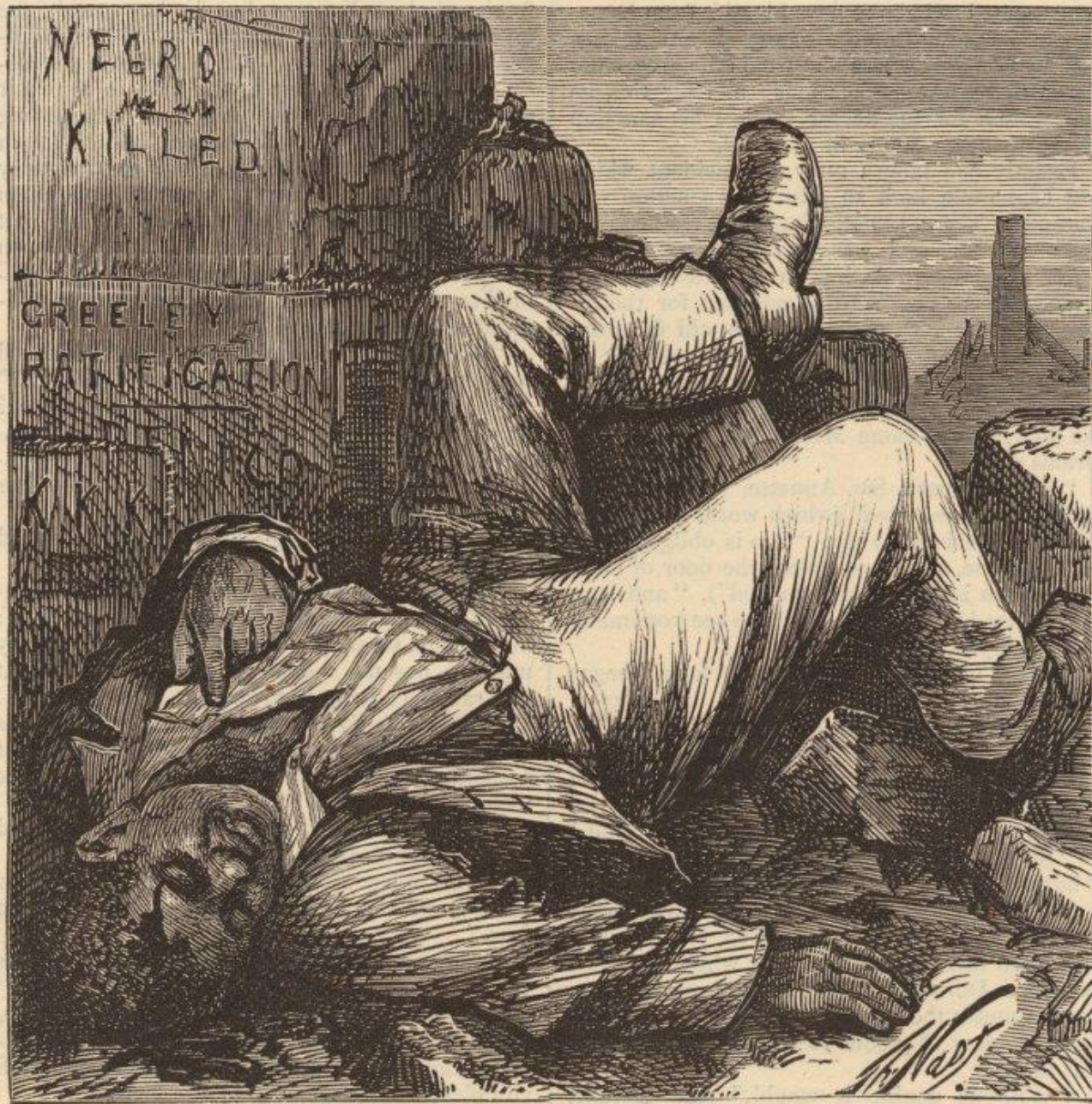

Terrorism

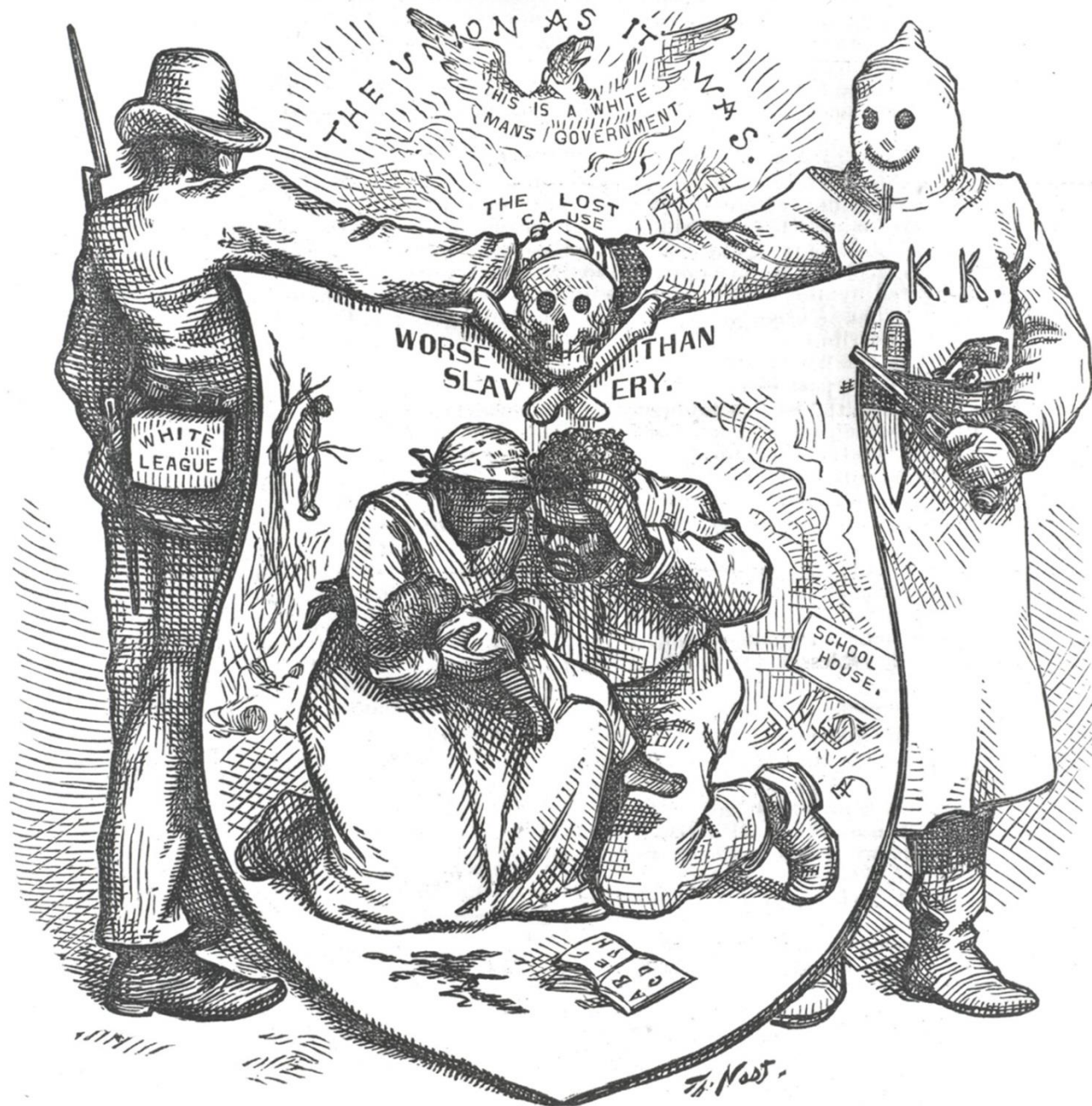
- The use of violence and intimidation to cause terror in the goal of achieving a political aim .
