- 25 States
- Bigger Population 21 million people
- Larger military Better Political Leadership (Lincoln)
 - Controlled the Seas
- Railroads More than double of South's railroads
- Greater amount of farmland
- More Industrialized Manufacturing -90% of the countries industry

SOUTH

- 11 States
- 9 million people -(1/2 million were slaves
- Better Military Leaders (Stonewall Jackson, Robert E. Lee)
- Defensive War Fighting to keep their way of life
- Gun culture more skilled soldiers
- Few factories dependent on imports
